The Fundraising Committee Meeting was held to discuss upcoming fundraising events and plan for May and June. Old Business: The Valentine's Day Bake Sale held on February 12 was not as popular as the Halloween bake sale, however, we received more compliments on the items and still earned \$383.00. Thank you to all who participated in donating their time baking, Patti French, Penny Jestes, Elizabeth Harter, and Amanda Lauko and thank you to everyone who donated items, including Barb Scott. A Huge thank you also to everyone who purchased items to support the sale.
