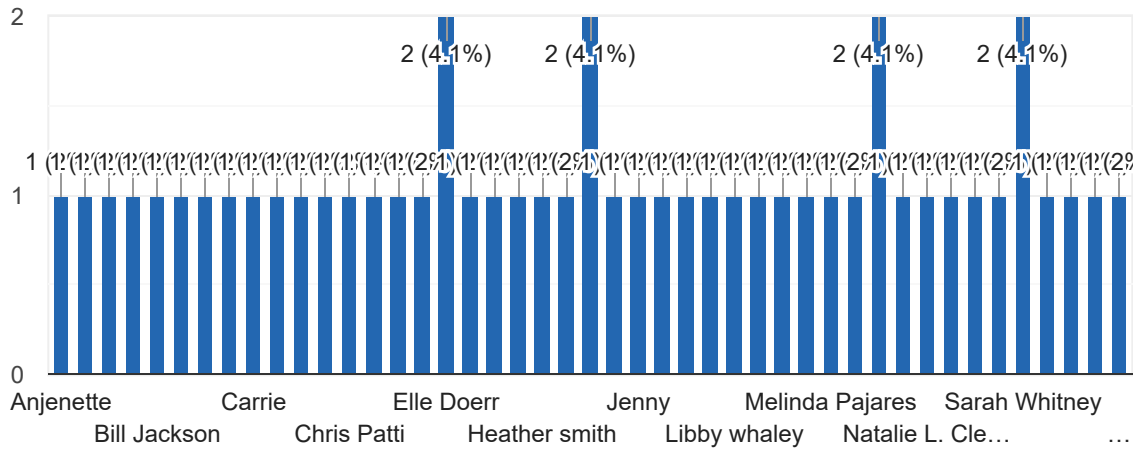

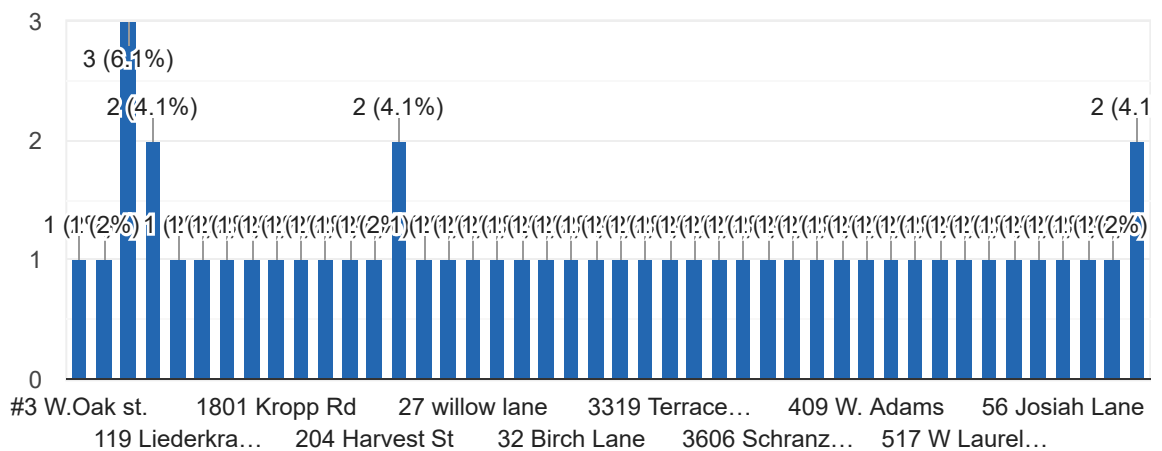

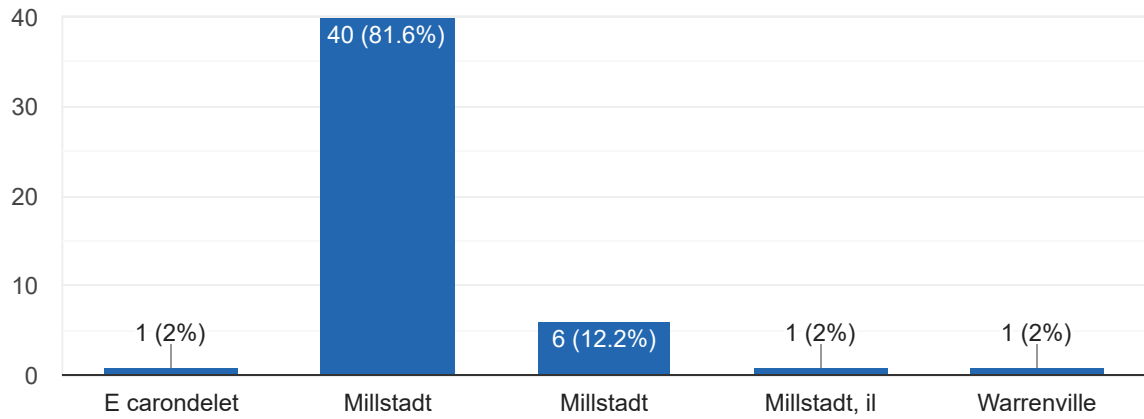

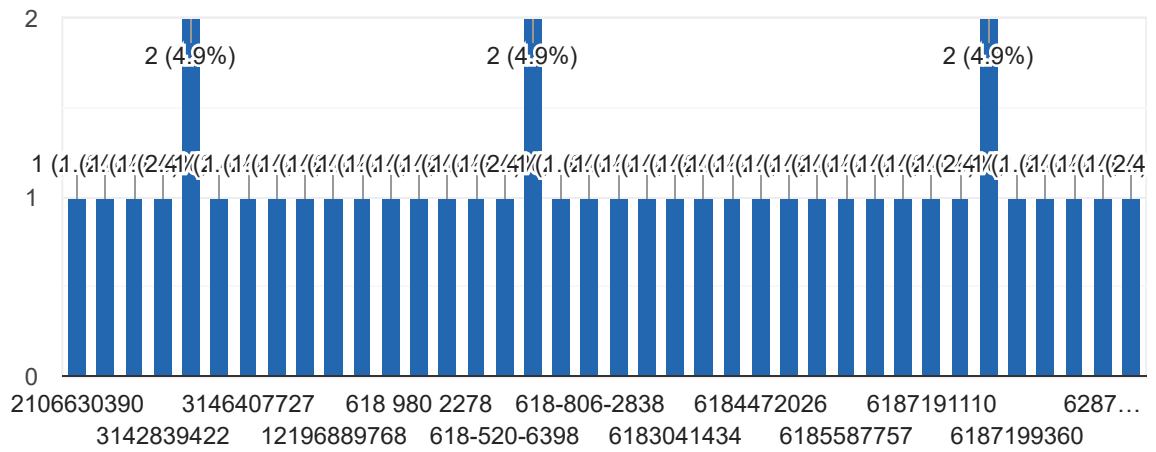

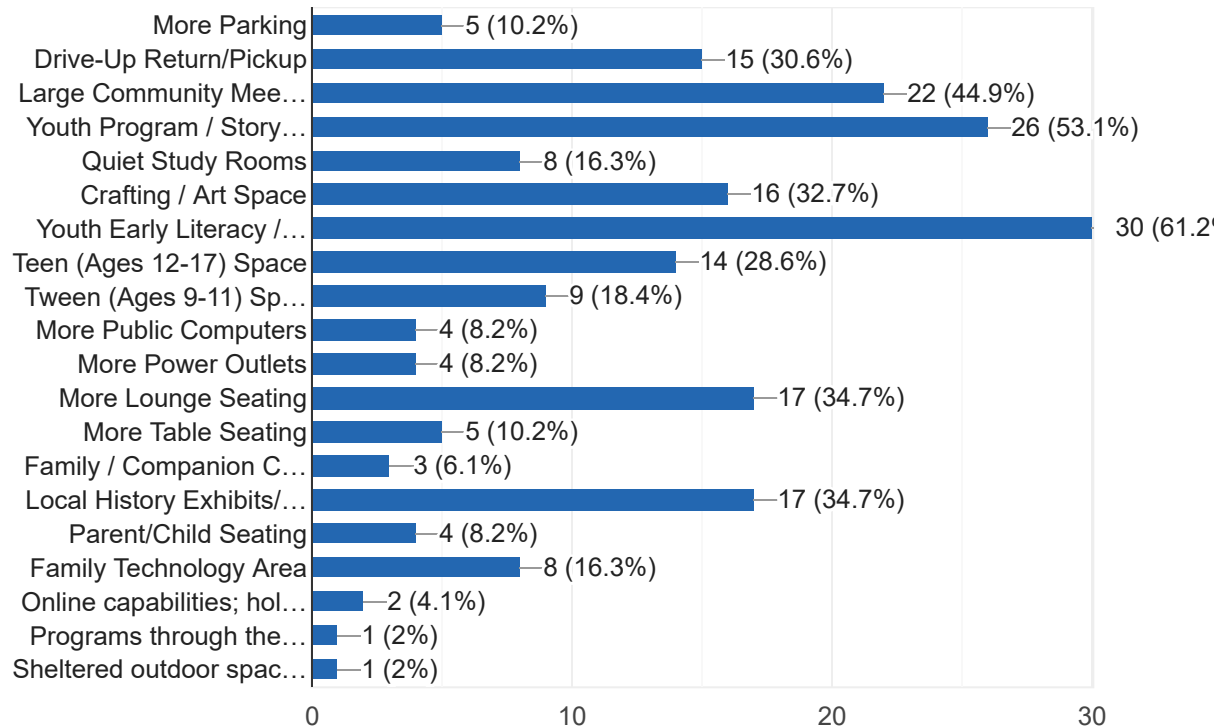

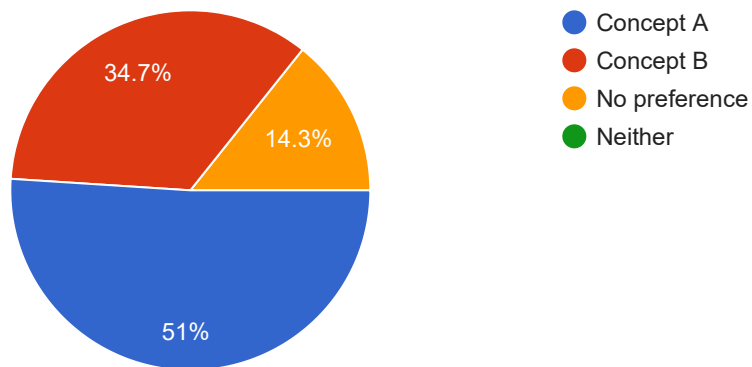
Which four of the following features or spaces are most important to you in a new library building? (Please select the four features most important to you)

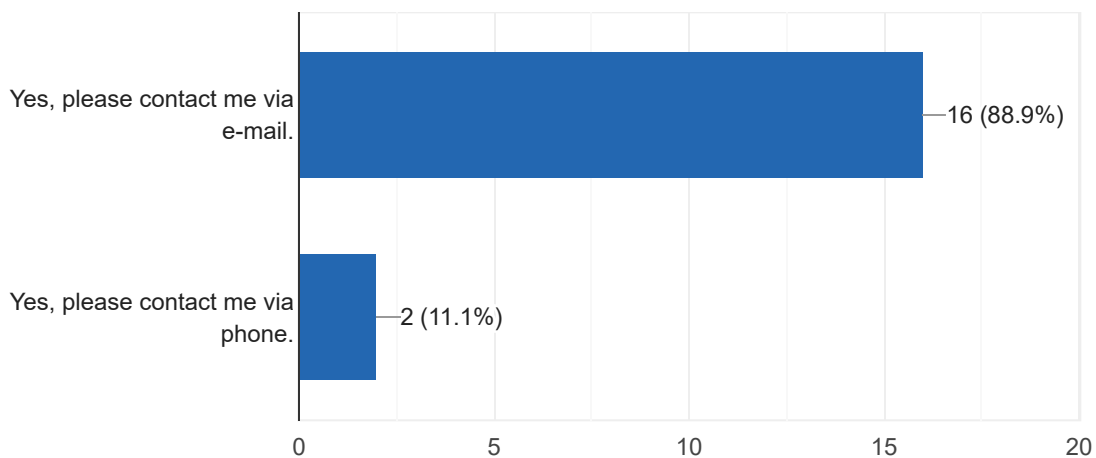

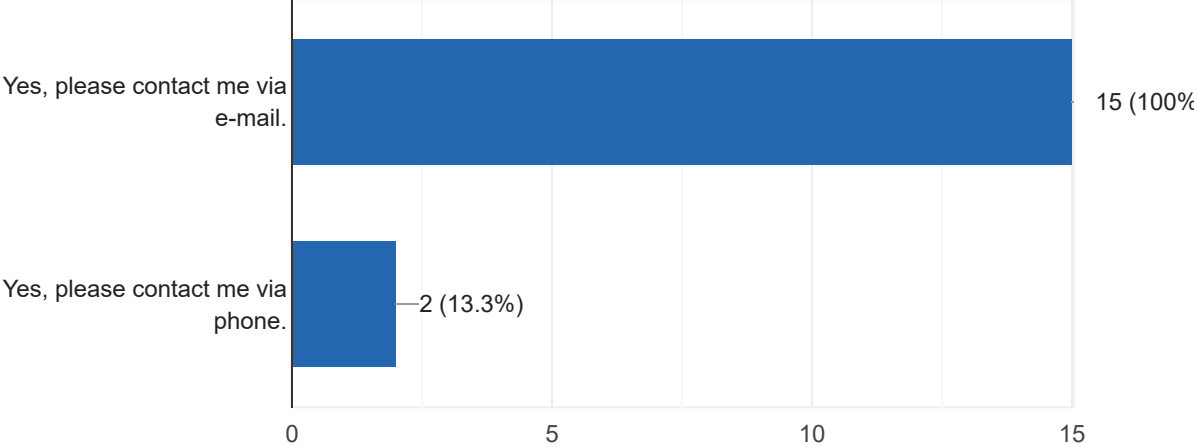
